

Key messages from the RCN Northern Ireland Board meeting

30 September 2024

- 1 In her opening remarks, the RCN Northern Ireland Board Chair formally welcomed Senior Business Accountant Ingrid Blake to her first Board meeting.
- 2 The Board received a further verbal

A response has been submitted to a Department for the Economy consultation on the content of an Employment Rights Bill for Northern Ireland, whilst the RCN's response to the Department of Health consultation on the principles underpinning the forthcoming safe and effective staffing legislation is currently being finalised.
